ANONYMOUS VERSION OF SCIENTIFIC STUDIES

In addition to the need to avoid author names and titles at the beginning of the main manuscript, authors must take other steps to ensure that their text moves through the peer review process. Therefore, before submitting your materials for publication, make sure that:

- you use impersonal form and passive voice when referring to your previous publications, such as '... as it has been shown before', citing [Anonymous, 2009];
- your illustrations do not contain data to identify your professional affiliation;
- you cite your already published works as [Anonymous, 2003];
- you list your publications in the bibliography at the end as '[Anonymous 2007], details omitted for the purpose of peer-reviewing';
- you have not used any information in the file names that could reveal your identity, and ensure that other identifiers on the computer document are also anonymous.
